

CARLO ALBERTO BARTOLETTI INTERNATIONAL AWARD 2018

The Carlo Alberto Bartoletti Foundation for promotion, research and safety in Aesthetic Medicine will award this year again the best thesis in Aesthetic Medicine, defended during the academic year 2016/2017, in honour of professor Carlo Alberto Bartoletti and in order to remember his untiring commitment to teaching and sharing of knowledge.

Article 1

The call is open to the best thesis in Aesthetic Medicine. The award will consist of the participation in the next **World Congress of Aesthetic Medicine** which will be held in Korea in 2019 and it will include free registration to the event, travel costs and free staying in the Conference Venue. In case of impossibility to participate, as evidenced by appropriate documentation, the winner will receive the monetary equivalent of the prize. He/she will also receive a plaque of acknowledgement for his/her scientific production.

Article 2

The candidates must have:

- a degree achieved at EFAMS - European Federation of Aesthetic Medicine Schools, or
- a two or three-year-long Italian University Master's degree in Aesthetic Medicine, or
- a Master's degree in Aesthetic Medicine or a degree achieved at a School of Aesthetic Medicine organised by Scientific Societies belonging to the International Union of Aesthetic Medicine (UIME)

And the candidates must have defended their thesis during the academic year 2016/2017.

Article 3

The Director of each educational institution mentioned in the previous article can send to the Secretariat of the Foundation a selection of 4 thesis. Title, Name, Surname and e-mail address of the author must be specified together with the date of the thesis' defence.

After that, the Secretariat of the Foundation will contact each author in order to request an excerpt of his/her thesis. It must be drawn up according to the Guidelines for the authors (attachment 1).

Article 4

The excerpts of the thesis, drawn up in accordance with the given guidelines, must be sent to the Secretariat – via email at the following address fondazionecabartoletti@lamedicinaestetica.it – by midnight on 15 February 2018.

Article 5

Each excerpt must be accompanied by the completed Participation Form (attachment 2) and by the CV Europass of the author.

Article 6

The prize will be awarded – at the discretion of the Selection Committee (article 8) – to the most original and innovative thesis in the field of Aesthetic Medicine.

The Committee will proclaim the winner based on the following criteria:

- Originality and importance of the topic
- Scientific methods used and importance of the results
- Bibliographic research

Article 7

All excerpts sent to participate in the Call can be selected to be published in the journal “La Medicina Estetica” or in the international journal “Aesthetic Medicine”; the winning excerpt will be published with the citation “Winner of the Carlo Alberto Bartoletti International Award 2018”.

Article 8

The Selection Committee will be formed of 9 members, who are experts in the field of Aesthetic Medicine and chosen among the directors of the participating educational schools.

Attachment 1

Guidelines for Authors

All articles in their final version – completed with name, surname, professional qualification and affiliation, address, phone number and e-mail address – must be sent in word format to the Secretariat of the *Carlo Alberto Bartoletti Foundation for promotion, research and safety in Aesthetic Medicine*

It is necessary to give the authorization to reproduce already published materials or to use portraits of people, in case they are recognizable.

The Author of the manuscripts should take responsibilities about the originality of content, correctness of results and authenticity of the resources.

The length of the article should be of 9-15 pages, excluded the summary and bibliography.

The article must be accompanied by the following parts:

1. Title, short and without abbreviations
2. Summary (maximum 15 lines at the most)
3. Name and surname of the author/s and the relative professional qualifications
4. Main author contact
5. Bibliography according to the AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION (AMA) CITATION STYLE
6. Keywords (2-5), using terms of the Index Medicus

All images, graphs and charts present within the word file must be numbered progressively and accompanied by the corresponding captions, with precise references in the text. Moreover, they should be sent separately according to the following modalities: the images must be sent in HD (at least 300 Dpi, in TIFF or JPEG format), while graphs and charts must be sent in Excel format.

Structure of the article

In case the article is a review (clinical cases, experiments on instruments etc.) it is sufficient to divide the text in paragraphs and subparagraphs, so that the different parts can be easily identified and the reading is facilitated.

In case it is a research, the article must be structured as a scientific work, that is to say:

- introduction, it summarizes the current state of knowledge;
- materials and methods described in details, in order to let the readers reproduce the results;
- results, reported accurately with references to charts and/or graphs;
- discussions and conclusions, focusing on the important and innovative aspects of the case study;
- literature, the references must be listed in order of citation within the text and with a progressive Arabian numbering.

The resources must be cited according to the AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION (AMA) CITATION STYLE. For this reason, they must contain the surname and name's initial of the author(s), original title of the article, title of the journal (in italic), year of publication, the number of the volume, the number of the journal, the number of first and last page. The footnote references must be written together with the number of the cited resource(s), in order of appearance.
